Unfortunately in its standard form it's quite a difficult chord to play because it's spread over three frets and requires three different fingers, this is tough for beginners.

Practice visualizing the D major chord on the guitar, and figure out which fingers are going to move to which string before you attempt to play the chord. It is also common for the first string not to ring when playing D major, due to the third finger lightly touching the first string at around the third fret.

A C# E G. The dominant 7 chord shares the I, III, V trial of a Major chord, with an added flattened 7th note.
